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"Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money; come ye, buy, and eat; yea, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price," Isa. 55:1.

"...freely ye have received, freely give," Mat. 10:8.

Please note:

The true Names of the Creator, Yahweh, and His Son Yahshua the Messiah, are used throughout this booklet, instead of the common but erroneous forms found in most translations of the Holy Scriptures.

These Names are found thousands of times in the Original, Inspired Scriptures, but most translators say they have "followed longstanding tradition" by inserting substitutes such as "LORD" and "GOD" in place of Yahweh's Name, and the Savior's True Name has been corrupted by centuries of Greek, Latin, and French influence. DID YAHSHUA NULLIFY THE LAW OF CLEAN AND UNCLEAN MEATS?

I originally published this booklet under the current title, but came to realize that for people to have a little better understanding of the spiritual reality, they need to also understand the physical. Therefore, I am adding this first article to the front of the booklet because first comes the physical, and then the spiritual.

Christianity utilizes several New Testament Scriptures in order to justify human consumption of any and everything that moves (or even doesn't move) on the face of the earth. Did Yahshua nullify the command of clean and unclean meats?

My family and I were enjoying some family time in the living room of our home at one time when our daughter disgustedly proclaimed that one of her acquaintances had gone to a restaurant where he ate a meal of frog legs. My wife and I began to inform her of the various foods which are considered to be delicacies by the modern-day world. Let's see, there's scallops, lobsters, crabs, crayfish shrimp, escargot, squid, oysters, pork, dog, horse, snake, turtle, etc., etc. Each time we would name something off, our daughter would squeal in horror and disbelief. Why? Because she had never knowledgeably eaten such things as we observe the Scriptural command to avoid unclean foods.

So many of our own relatives as well as the modern-day Christian world would point their fingers at us laughingly informing us of the good tasting foods that we are missing out on. Most of them do so because they believe that Yahshua came and did away with the command to avoid unclean foods.

There are two key areas of Scripture which are utilized to justify this belief. The first one is found in Mark 7:19 which states, "And He saith unto them, 'Are ye so without understanding also? Do ye not perceive, that whatsoever thing from without entereth into the man, it cannot defile him; because it entereth not into his heart, but into the belly, and goeth out into the draught,' purging all meats?"

The second key Scripture is found in Col. 2:16-17, "Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday,

or of the new moon, or of the sabbath *days*: Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body *is* of the Messiah."

EXAMINING OR ANALYZING

Much of the world has allowed many Scriptural things to be changed or done away because of statements such as these which have been taken out of context. What should be done before any Scriptural command is changed in the New Testament is to search out those Scriptures in order to see just what has been said concerning the topic. Let's take animal sacrifices, for instance. We understand that Yahshua's one sacrifice satisfied the requirements of all animal sacrifices commanded by Moses (the Torah). Therefore, we don't offer the physical sacrifices made by the hands of man any longer.

Now let's look at Mark, chapter 7 to see what the topic was that brought on the statement in verse 19. In verses 1-5, "Then came together unto Him the Pharisees and certain of the scribes, which came from Jerusalem. 2. And when they saw some of His disciples eat bread with defiled, that is to say, with unwashen hands, they found fault. (3. For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, except they wash *their* hands oft, eat not, holding the tradition of the elders. 4. And *when they come* from the market, except they wash, they eat not. And many other things there be, which they have received to hold, as the washing of cups, and pots, brasen vessels, and of tables.) 5. Then the Pharisees and scribes asked Him, 'Why walk not Thy disciples according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashen hands'?"

Notice carefully that the subject is not clean and unclean foods, but rather is whether to eat with washed or unwashed hands. The extensive washings spoken of here are not found in Yahweh's commands, but were added as traditions of men. Of course, as Yahshua proclaimed in Mk. 7:6-13, man's own traditions become much more important in his eyes than the commandments of Yahweh and eventually those man-made traditions are twisted to the point of overthrowing the commands of Yahweh.

Yahshua continued in verses 14-21, "And when he had called all the people *unto him*, he said unto them, Hearken unto me every one *of you*, and understand: 15 There is nothing from without a man, that entering into him can defile him: but the things which come out of him, those are they that defile the man. 16 If any man have ears to

hear, let him hear. 17 And when he was entered into the house from the people, his disciples asked him concerning the parable. 18 And he saith unto them, Are ye so without understanding also? Do ye not perceive, that whatsoever thing from without entereth into the man, *it* cannot defile him; 19 Because it entereth not into his heart, but into the belly, and goeth out into the draught, **purging all meats**? 20 And he said, That which cometh out of the man, that defileth the man. 21 For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, 22 Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: 23 All these evil things come from within, and defile the man."

Now what does it mean when He says, "Purging all meats?" The KJV utilizes old English renderings for certain words. The word "meats" utilized here doesn't mean the meat of an animal, but rather foods. He was making a scientific statement wherein the body has the ability to extract from the foods that which is beneficial and to eliminate that which is not.

So what had the Scribes, Pharisees, Sadducees, etc. done? They had pronounced even clean foods to be unclean if eaten with unwashed hands. Yahshua was simply correcting their added traditions which made Yahweh's word of none effect.

PETER'S EXAMPLE

If the true meaning of "Purging all meats" has to do with the cleansing of all animals for consumption then why did Peter resist eating unclean animals in Acts, chapter 10?

The Centurion Cornelius was visited by the Angel of Yahweh who informed him that he should send for the Apostle Peter (Acts 10:1-8). "On the morrow, as they went on their journey, and drew nigh unto the city, Peter went up upon the housetop to pray about the sixth hour: 10 And he became very hungry, and would have eaten: but while they made ready, he fell into a trance, 11 And saw heaven opened, and a certain vessel descending unto him, as it had been a great sheet knit at the four corners, and let down to the earth: 12 Wherein were all manner of fourfooted beasts of the earth, and wild beasts, and creeping things, and fowls of the air. 13 And there came a voice to him, Rise, Peter; kill, and eat. 14 But Peter said, **Not so, Master; for I have never eaten any thing that is common** **unclean**. 15 And the voice *spake* unto him again the second time, What Yahweh hath cleansed, *that* call not thou common. 16 This was done thrice: and the vessel was received up again into heaven," vv. 9-16.

While the Christian world also utilizes these Scriptures to justify eating unclean animals, the question is, Why was Peter so mystified at this command? Hadn't he been with Yahshua years earlier when Yahshua responded to the Pharisees in Mk. 7? Shouldn't this have joggled his memory concerning that incident and reminded him that Yahshua had purged all meats? Shouldn't Peter now have said, Hey! I get it now! It's OK for us to eat anything that Yahweh has created under the sun.

But the Scriptures reveal that Peter was perplexed concerning this vision, "Now while **Peter doubted in himself what this vision which he had seen should mean**, behold, the men which were sent from Cornelius had made enquiry for Simon's house, and stood before the gate, 18 and called and asked whether Simon, which was surnamed Peter, were lodged there. 19. **While Peter thought on the vision**, the spirit said unto him, 'Behold, three men seek thee. 20. Arise therefore and get thee down, and go with them, doubting nothing: for I have sent them'," Acts. 10:17-20.

When brought before Cornelius, Peter finally understood the true meaning of the vision, "Then Peter opened his mouth, and said, 'Of a truth I perceive that Yahweh is no respecter of persons: but in every nation He that feareth Him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with Him," Acts. 10:35-35. (Refer also to Acts 15:7-14)

The major point is that, had Yahweh intended to cleanse unclean foods, then the spirit certainly would have revealed it to Peter and the other apostles at this time, but such was not the purpose.

People of other nations and ethnicity had been viewed by the Hebrews as being common and unclean. Many were even referred to as dogs. Yahweh's vision to Peter was making the point to him and the rest of the converted Hebrews that He no longer was considering these peoples as common and unclean.

ANALYZING COL. 2:16-17

"Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath *days*; which are a shadow of things to come; but the body *is* of the Messiah." Notice that the words *days* and *is* are in italics. This means that they are not a part of the original writings, but are supplied in order to supposedly help in understanding what is written. However in this case, with the word "*is*" supplied, there is no help in understanding, but rather confusion.

What should be understood here is that no man should judge us concerning these things but the body of the Messiah. These things, meat (food), drink, holydays, sabbaths, etc., are a shadow of things to come.

The Sabbath and holydays are tools Yahweh gave His people in order to not only rest and rejoice before Him at His appointed times, but to understand His wondrous plan of salvation. Those who are not observing these days are basically ignorant that there is a schedule of events which must take place at the time that Yahweh has ordained them to take place. (Order our free booklet entitled *Col. 2:16-17 or Holidays Vs. Holidays*, also our article entitled *Should A New Testament Believer Observe The Sabbath Day?* and our tract entitled *Just Who Was It That Sanctified Sunday Worship?*)

Believe it or not, foods, especially meats, can identify which Messiah you are serving! There is the true Messiah Who is the Lamb of Elohim. Then there is the false Messiah, who may be referred to as the lamb of Elohim, but whose followers ingest every kind of flesh imaginable which is a type of blending the truth about the Messiah with the unclean paganistic and heathenistic doctrines of the world. (Order our free article entitled *The Covenant Of The Clean And Unclean*)

Paul writes, "Wherefore if ye be dead with the Messiah from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to ordinances, (touch not; taste not; handle not; which all are to perish with the using;) **after the commandments and doc-trines of men**?" Col. 2:20-23.

Yes, it is true that if we observe the command of clean and unclean foods, that we are submitting ourselves to the ordinance of touch not, taste not, handle not, etc. But this command is not after the commandments and doctrines of men, but rather after the command and doctrine of Yahweh! Paul is writing against the commandments and doctrines of men (such as, eat no meat on Friday, or abstain from certain kinds of foods during the Lenten season, etc.). He is not contradicting the commandments and doctrines of Yahweh.

MAN'S PHILOSOPHY

Near the beginning of chapter two, Paul speaks of the mystery of Elohim, and of the Father and of the Messiah in Whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge (vv 2-3). Then he warns us by saying, "And this I say, lest any man should beguile you with enticing words," v. 4.

Who is it that beguiles? Didn't the serpent beguile Eve in the garden of Eden? How did he beguile her? First by contradicting Yahweh's word and then stating an outright lie. The serpent beguiled Eve and enticed her to directly disobey the command of Yahweh. What did he entice her to do? Wasn't it to take a food that was forbidden and eat of it?

Notice Paul's additional warning in verse 8, "Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, **after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world** and not after the Messiah."

It's the tradition of men and the rudiments (elementary principles) of the world that deceive and spoil us.

Philosophy is a combination of two word "philos" and "sophos". Philos is the Greek word for "love" and sophos means "wisdom." Philosophy, therefore, means "lover of wisdom." But which wisdom is this word speaking of?

Webster's New World Dictionary defines philosophy as; 1. orig. love of, or the search for, wisdom or knowledge 2. theory or logical analysis of the principles of the universe: included in philosophy are ethics, aesthetics, logic, epistemology, metaphysics, etc. 3. the general principles or laws of a field of knowledge, activity, etc. [the philosophy of economics] 4. a) a particular system of principles for the conduct of life b) a treatise covering such a system. 5. a) a study of human morals, character, and behavior b) mental balance or composure thought of as resulting from this; calmness.

Notice that philosophy includes wisdom, knowledge, principles, laws, morals, character, behavior, balance and composure, but it all has to do with the way that man dictates these things. Not one thing is said about Yahweh's commands, wisdom, knowledge, morality, behavior, principles, etc. as revealed in His Holy Word. Man's philosophy has nothing to do with Biblical wisdom!

Furthermore, "vain deceit" can also be translated as "empty delu-

sion." Delusion is defined as; a false belief or opinion, a false, persistent belief not substantiated by sensory or objective evidence. (*Webster's New World Dictionary*)

Thus, vain deceit or empty delusion has to do with something someone persistently believes in, but cannot be proven by sensory or objective evidence. In the case of clean and unclean foods, the evidence is Yahweh's word!

EVERY CREATURE GOOD

Paul wrote to Timothy, "Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron; forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which Yahweh hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth. For every creature of Yahweh is good, and nothing to be refused, if it be received with thanksgiving: for it is sanctified by the word of Yahweh and prayer," 1 Tim. 4:1-5.

People look at this Scripture and then proclaim, See! Paul has said that we can eat everything that has been created. All animals are now good for food.

However, the key to understanding what Paul was speaking of is found in the very last verse, "...it is sanctified by the word of Yahweh..." We find out what was sanctified by the word of Yahweh by going to Lev. 11 and Deut. 14. Yahweh reveals there what He sanctified for consumption and what He did not.

If you believe in Yahweh's word, then it must be the foundation upon which you build your life and knowledge. This means that you must refrain from so many things that the world, as a whole, delights in and pursues. This also means that the true believer may have to suffer from wants, lacks or even desires that the world simply doesn't have to suffer. This makes the life of a true believer to be much more undesirable that the life of those seemingly enjoying the things of this world to the hilt. But our reward is future in the kingdom. Yahshua said that we must love Him and His way more than the world.

Yahweh's word must rule our lives in everything that we observe. We do not rejoice in the pagan holiday system that we see the world rejoicing in (Sunday, Christmas, Easter, Valentine's Day, Halloween, etc., etc.) The fear of Yahweh is the beginning of our wisdom (Prov. 9:10). The fear of Yahweh is also the beginning of knowledge (Prov. 1:7). Therefore, we observe the holydays that He has commanded (Sabbath, Passover, Unleavened Bread, Pentecost, Trumpets, Atonement, Tabernacles, Last Great Day, New Moon, etc.) We also observe His commands concerning the foods that we eat.

Remember, one of the first things a doctor will do when someone has developed heart trouble is take them off of pork. Why? Because pork has a fat content in its meat that builds up in a person's system and is almost impossible to eliminate.

One deceased brother who was a farmer at heart always told me that if they were working on farm equipment and were out of grease, they would utilize pork lard because of its ability to resist high heat. Yahweh commanded, "Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, Ye shall eat no manner of fat, of ox, or of sheep, or of goat," Lev. 7:23.

Amazingly, the fat of these animals can be eliminated from the body through fevers, but pork fat can't. Yahweh knows what is better, and healthy for us, and reveals it in His word. If we live by His word, our chances for long life and health are greatly increased. We encourage all to do their best to follow His word, and where there is difficulty, seek Him. After all, He is the One Who Delivers.

Following is a list of clean creatures that we are allowed to eat and unclean creatures that we are not:

CLEAN MEATS

- 1. ANIMALS: Beef, sheep, antelope, buffalo, caribou, deer, elk, gazelle, giraffe, goat, hart, ibex, llama, moose, reindeer
- 2. FISH/SEAFOOD: anchovy, bass, bluefish, carp, cod, crappie, flounder, grouper, grunt, haddock, halibut, hardhead, herring, mackerel, minnow, perch, pickerel, pike, rockfish, salmon, shad, smelt, snapper, sole, sunfish, tarpon, trout, tuna (albacore, bonita, yellowtail)
- 3. BIRDS: chicken, dove, grouse, guinea fowl, partridge, peacock, pheasant, pigeon, songbirds, quail, turkey
- 4. CREEPERS: different types of locusts which includes grasshoppers.

UNCLEAN MEATS

- 1. ANIMALS: badger, bear, camel, cat, cheetah, coney, coyote, donkey, dog, elephant, fox, gorilla, hare, hippopotamus, horse, hyena, jackal, kangaroo, leopard, lion, monkey, mule, onager, opossum, panther, peccary, pig, porcupine, quagga, raccoon, rhinoceros, skunk, squirrel, tiger, wallaby, weasel, zebra.
- 2. FISH/SEA CREATURES: abalone, catfish, clam, crab, crayfish, cuttlefish, dolphin, eel, jellyfish, limpet, lobster, marlin, mussel, octopus, otter, oyster, prawn, scallop, shark, shrimp, squid, sturgeon, walrus, whale.
- 3. BIRDS: albatross, bat, bittern, buzzard, condor, cormorant, crane, crow, cuckoo, *duck, eagle, flamingo, *goose, grosbeak, gull, hawk, heron, kite, lapwing, loon, osprey, ostrich, owl, pelican, penguin, plover, raven, stork, swallow, *swan, swift, vulture, *water hen, woodpecker.
- 4. CREEPERS: crocodile, frog, insects (all, except the locust family), lizard, mole, mouse, newt, rat, salamander, snail, slug, toad, turtle.

* In both Lev. 11 and Dt. 14 the swan is mentioned, but a check of the Hebrew word from whence it is translated shows that it has to do with the water hen. The swan, duck and goose are all water hens, therefore we suggest that their flesh not be eaten.

THE SPIRITUAL REALITY OF EATING SWINE'S FLESH

Are you one of those who relishes eating the flesh of the pig, or swine? Do you think that the Savior cleansed all meat so that swine's flesh is now allowable? Have you ever thought that there is the physical, fleshly, carnal world in which we live, and there is the world of the spirit in which Yahweh and His angels live? Scripture says that the serpent called the devil and Satan has deceived the whole world (Rev. 12, esp. v. 9). Are you one of those who has been deceived? Hopefully this treatise will open your eyes to see the difference.

You and I were born into a physical world. The physical world is an antithesis to the true spiritual world. That isn't to say that we aren't part spiritual, because there is a spirit in man (Job 32:8). But man's spirit is not subject to the Spirit of Yahweh unless Yahweh calls us to repentance; we are baptized in Yahshua, and given the Holy Spirit of Yahweh. The Apostle Paul reveals this in 1 Corinthians 2:6-14, "Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to nought: But we speak the wisdom of Elohim in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which Yahweh ordained before the world unto our glory: Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Sovereign of glory. But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which Yahweh hath prepared for them that love him. But Yahweh hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of Elohim. For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of Yahweh knoweth no man, but the Spirit of Yahweh. Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of Yahweh; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of Yahweh. Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Spirit teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual. But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of Yahweh: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned."

Do you get that? There is the spirit of man, that imparts to man, the things of man, and there is the Spirit of Yahweh that imparts the things of Yahweh. The things of Yahweh are mysteries that only those who possess the Spirit of Yahweh can come to understand. It isn't possible for those who only have the spirit of man to come to understand the things, the mysteries of Yahweh!

Now, before I proceed, I must let you know that just because Yahweh has given me (the author of this article) His Spirit for the discernment of spiritual things, this does not make me better than anyone else. I am blessed by Yahweh to have His Spirit and to be able to see these things, but that is for the purpose of serving you with many of His marvelous truths, HalleluYah!!!!

The Prophet Isaiah writes, "I am sought of them that asked not for me; I am found of them that sought me not: I said, Behold me, behold me, unto a nation that was not called by my name. I have spread out my hands all the day unto a rebellious people, which walketh in a way that was not good, after their own thoughts; A people that provoketh me to anger continually to my face; that sacrificeth in gardens, and burneth incense upon altars of brick; Which remain among the graves, and lodge in the monuments, which eat swine's flesh, and broth of abominable things is in their vessels; Which say, Stand by thyself, come not near to me; for I am holier than thou. These are a smoke in my nose, a fire that burneth all the day. Behold, it is written before me: I will not keep silence, but will recompense, even recompense into their bosom, Your iniquities, and the iniquities of your fathers together, saith Yahweh, which have burned incense upon the mountains, and blasphemed me upon the hills: therefore will I measure their former work into their bosom," 65:1-7.

Again, he writes, "For, behold, Yahweh will come with fire, and with his chariots like a whirlwind, to render his anger with fury, and his rebuke with flames of fire. For by fire and by his sword will Yahweh plead with all flesh: and the slain of Yahweh shall be many. They that sanctify themselves, and purify themselves in the gardens behind one tree in the midst, <u>eating swine's flesh</u>, and the abomination, and the mouse, shall be consumed together, saith Yahweh," 66:15-17.

These people are eating swine's flesh in both prophecies. But instead of something that is approved, the indication here is that these people are committing abominations. We know that modern day Christianity claims that the Savior cleansed all meats, but such is not the case. We address this in our article entitled "*Did Yahshua Nullify the Law of Clean and Unclean Meats*?" (You can order this free of charge.)

THE TWO MESSIAHS

Christianity has been looking for the anti-christ for millennia. They understand that there is the true Christ (Messiah), and the false christ, or anti-christ. The anti-christ will deceive people into following him rather than the true Christ, or Messiah.

Consider this, the True Messiah will be followed, and worshipped in truth. Yahshua said, "Yahweh is Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth," Jn. 4:24. The false messiah/christ will not be leading the people in (the Holy) spirit and in truth.

So, let's take a look at the truth of the situation.... The Savior proclaimed, "Think not that I am come to <u>destroy the law</u>, or the prophets: <u>I am not come to destroy</u>, but to fulfil. For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled. Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven," Mt. 5:17-19.

The teaching in Christianity is that "the law is done away." Isn't something wrong here? Christianity bases their premise on the writings of Paul, but Paul wrote, "Do we then make void the law through faith? Yahweh forbid: yea, we establish the law," Ro. 3:31.

Paul also says, "What shall we say then? Is the law sin? Yahweh forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet," Ro. 7:7.

The Apostle John wrote, "Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for **sin is the transgression of the law**. And ye know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin. Whosoever abideth in him sinneth not: whosoever sinneth hath not seen him, neither known him. Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous," 1 Jn. 3:4-7.

James writes, "Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of Elohim: for Elohim cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man: But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death," Jas. 1:13-15.

Again, he writes, "For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all. For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law. So speak ye, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of liberty," Jas. 10-12.

We know that James is speaking of the ten commandments here because he is speaking of the seventh commandment concerning adultery, and then the sixth which forbids murder. But these are only two out of the ten. However, he said that if we keep the law (commandments) yet offend in one point, then we are guilty of all.

One of the chief commandments that the followers of the antichrist, or the false messiah will be breaking is the fourth commandment concerning the Sabbath day. Yahweh commanded the seventh day Sabbath to be observed, however, Islam observes the sixth day of the week (Friday), and Christianity observes the first day (Sunday) rather than the seventh day Sabbath. This makes them guilty of offending the whole law, and transgressors.

Furthermore, none of them consider the true name of our Creator, and the true name of the Savior to be important. Thus, they are taking His name in vain.

Therefore, there is the true Messiah whose name is Yahshua, Who fulfilled the law and made it honorable, and there is the false messiah, the anti-christ Jesus, whose name is false, and leads the people away from the commandments of Yahweh.

Even though the name Jesus appears in almost all of the English New Testament translations, this is a false name. The Savior's name was equivalent to the name of the patriarch Joshua (Yahshua) son of Nun who led Israel into the promised land. There is no "J" in the Hebrew, nor the Greek language. Neither was there a "J" in the English until the 17th century. The Savior would never have been called by the name Jesus.

ENTER ROME

The Psalmist Asaph writes, "Thou hast brought a vine out of Egypt: thou hast cast out the heathen, and planted it. Thou preparedst room before it, and didst cause it to take deep root, and it filled the land. The hills were covered with the shadow of it, and the boughs thereof were like the goodly cedars. She sent out her boughs unto the sea, and her branches unto the river. Why hast thou then broken down her hedges, so that all they which pass by the way do pluck her? The <u>boar</u> out of *<u>the wood</u> doth waste it, and the wild beast of the field doth devour it," Psa. 80:8-13.

*The Companion Bible by E. W. Bullinger states, "the wood = forest. The Heb. word for forest here (*miyya'ar*), has the letter Ayin (\mathfrak{V}) suspended. This is the second of four such suspended letters (the other two being Job 38. 13, 15). Read with this letter, the word means "forest"; without it, and with and Aleph (\mathfrak{s}) instead, it is miyy'ar, "river". The ancient Jewish interpreters took this suspended letter as denoting that, when innocent, Israel would be assailed only by a power weak as a river animal; but, when guilty, it would be destroyed by a power as strong as a land animal. Until the Roman power arose (whose military ensign was the "boar"), it was understood as "river" (meaning Egypt); but afterward the Sept., Chald., and Vulg. read "forest"." (p. 800)

In accordance with the book of Daniel chapters 2 and 7, the fourth kingdom to have rule over the Mediterranean would be Rome. Rome was presented in Daniel 2 as legs of iron, then feet of iron and clay, and finally toes of iron and miry clay. In Daniel 7 Rome is presented as the great and terrible beast, that is, an indescribable, mysterious beast kingdom. This is also the beast that is addressed in the book of revelation.

The kingdom that preceded Rome was the Macedonian-Greek kingdom represented by the belly and thighs of brass/copper in Daniel 2, and the leopard with four heads and four wings in Daniel 7. It is a known fact that the Seleucid kings worshipped and served Zeus and always promoted him over all other gods, including Yahweh. Antiochus Epiphanes is the Seleucid king who entered into Jerusalem, set up a statue of Zeus in the holy of holies of Yahweh's temple, offered swine's flesh on the altar, and splattered the temple walls with swine's broth. He did all that he could to defile Yahweh's temple and people.

When the Romans came into their power, they were tolerant of the Jewish people for a while, but we know for a fact that they are the ones who destroyed the temple during the Jewish rebellion in 69-70 CE. The historical facts are that when the temple was destroyed, the Romans took their military ensigns to the place where the temple had been, and made sacrifice to them also proclaiming Titus to be Caesar. Since the boar was one of their chief military ensigns, then they followed suit with Antiochus by sacrificing to the boar/swine.

HEBREW FOR SWINE

The Hebrew word for "boar" and "swine" is *chaziyr*. It is rendered thusly in *Strong's Exhaustive Concordance* - חזיר chaziyr, *khaz-eer'*.

Now this is interesting to this author because the Latin word for "Caesar" is "Kaiser", which would be a very similar rendering to the Hebrew word for boar or swine (*chaziyr* - khazeer). The Caesars were the family of Julius and Augustus Caesar who ruled the city and kingdom of Rome. They, especially Augustus and his lineage, became worshipped as gods.


A history of the Caesars/Kaisars/Czars reveals that they were some of the most wicked and profane people imaginable.

Constantine the Great eventually inherited the office of Augustus and Caesar. He was head, emperor of the fourth kingdom of Daniel chapter 2, and the great, terrible, indescribable beast of Daniel 7, and the book of Revelation. He was not a friend of Yahshua's followers/disciples, but rather an enemy. In Rabbinic literature, Rome is Esau, Edom, Amalek, Seir, and Tyre. They declare that it is associated with the eagle and the **pig**. (See *Encyclopedia Judaica*) Constantine entered into the New Testament assembly in similar fashion to the Trojan Horse, took over as the civil head of the Roman Empire (the emperor), and the ecclesiastical head under the title of *Pontifex Maximus*, and began to dictate the manner of worship.

He established Sunday, the first day of the week, the day of the pagan sun god, as the day of worship in lieu of Yahweh's commanded seventh day Sabbath. He and his successors corrupted the Messianic assembly into the Christian church that is extant in today's world.

THE LABARAM

On the eve of the battle of Milvain Bridge, he supposedly was shown a vision of a cross (called a labaram) which contained the Greek letters Chi and Rho, which were the first two letters of the Greek word Christos (Christ). He was told to conquer by that sign.

Here is what Eusebius wrote about this Labaram, "A Description of the Standard of the Cross, which the Romans now call the Labarum." "Now it was made in the following manner. A long spear, overlaid with gold, formed the figure of the cross by means of a transverse bar laid over it. On the top of the whole was fixed a wreath of gold and precious stones; and within this, the symbol of **the Saviour's name**, two letters indicating the name of Christ by means of its initial characters, the letter P being intersected by X in its centre: and these letters the emperor was in the habit of wearing on his helmet at a later period. From the cross-bar of the spear was suspended a cloth, a royal piece, covered with a profuse embroidery of most brilliant precious stones; and which, being also richly interlaced with gold, presented an indescribable degree of beauty to the beholder. This banner was of a square form, and the upright staff, whose lower section was of great length, of <u>the pious emperor and his children</u> on its upper part, beneath the trophy of the cross, and immediately above the embroidered banner."

"The emperor constantly made use of this sign of salvation as a safeguard against every adverse and hostile power, and commanded that others similar to it should be carried at the head of all his armies." (*Wikipedia*)

Constantine was a deceiver, and Eusebius aided him in this deception! Christ is not the name of the Savior. Christ is supposed to be the Greek word for "anoint, or anointed." It is supposed to be equivalent to the Hebrew word "Messiah." Messiah would, or should be with the article "the" which would indicate "the anointed." No proper name was ever preceded by the article "the." It is only a title. The Labaram above with Constantine and his two sons is, in reality, revealing him to be "the christ," "the anointed," "the savior" of the empire.

Thus, the Kaiser/chaziyr (swine) was the new military standard.

HESUS/JESUS

Constantine knew of the Druidic savior named Esus (Hesus), because he had served with his father in Britain. This savior's name was written as Esus on the west European mainland, but written as Yesu in the British Isles. Both were pronounced as "Hesus." He skillfully blended Esus and Yesu into the Latin Yesus. It was no great feat to claim that the Greek Iesous was to be pronounced the same and refer to the same savior. However, Iesous is translated as Joshua/Yahshua in the Torah, the book of Joshua, Haggai, Zechariah, etc. The Spanish people preserve the pronunciation Hesus for Jesus in today's world.

King James followed suit with Constantine. Very few people have questioned the differences between the Old Testament rendering of the Greek name Iesous as Joshua, and the New Testament rendering as Jesus. However, we must do so for the sake of the truth.

The swine is an unclean animal, forbidden to be eaten by Yahweh's people, "And Yahweh spake unto Moses and to Aaron, saying unto them, Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, These are the beasts which ye shall eat among all the beasts that are on the earth. Whatsoever parteth the hoof, and is clovenfooted, and cheweth the cud, among the beasts, that shall ve eat. Nevertheless these shall ye not eat of them that chew the cud, or of them that divide the hoof: as the camel, because he cheweth the cud, but divideth not the hoof; he is unclean unto you. And the coney, because he cheweth the cud, but divideth not the hoof; he is unclean unto you. And the hare, because he cheweth the cud, but divideth not the hoof; he is unclean unto you. And the swine, though he divide the hoof, and be clovenfooted, yet he cheweth not the cud; he is unclean to you. Of their flesh shall ye not eat, and their carcase shall ye not touch; they are unclean to you," Lev. 11:1-8. (See also Dt. 14:1-8)

Just to make a point, animals were considered to be either clean or unclean in the pre-flood world as Noah was commanded to take seven pairs of clean animals and only one pair of unclean, "And Yahweh said unto Noah, Come thou and all thy house into the ark; for thee have I seen righteous before me in this generation. Of every clean beast thou shalt take to thee by sevens, the male and his female: and of beasts that are not clean by two, the male and his female," Gen. 7:1-2. This was long before the deliverance of Israel out of the Egyptian bondage by the hand of Moses.

GRAVES/SEPULCHRES

Yahweh speaks out against those who, "...provoketh me to anger continually to my face; that sacrificeth in gardens, and burneth incense upon altars of brick; Which remain among the graves, and lodge in the monuments," Isa. 65:3-4.

What does it mean to remain among the graves? Did you know that almost all of the great churches of Europe have had a custom of burying a "dead (so-called) saint" in their sanctuary, generally also naming the church after him?

Not only that, but they place crosses outside and inside their

churches. What are these crosses symbols of? Go to Arlington National Cemetery and you will find out what they symbolize. The Pictorial Hebrew letter tau (\dagger) is the last letter of the Hebrew alphabet. It has to do with several things, but one main thing is that it represents the end, the last. While Yahshua declares that He is the Tau in the book of Revelation, the simple fact of the matter is that the commandment decrees, "Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I Yahweh thy Elohim am a jealous El, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments," Ex. 20:4-6.

When one goes to church, which will have the cross lifted up on its steeple as a **monument**, and crosses on its altar toward which people worship, they are fulfilling Isaiah 65, and 66. In reality, they are entering a **tomb**, grave, sepulchre.

THE EUCHARIST

The Apostle Paul informs us, "For I have received of the Master that which also I delivered unto you, That the Master Yahshua the same night in which he was betrayed took bread: And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me. After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me," 1 Cor. 11:23-25.

The Caesars/Kaisers/*chaziyrs* (swine), kings, leaders, and priests of the earth have appropriated this act to their own form of faith calling it the Eucharist, or communion.

The truth concerning the kingdom of heaven is that one is called to repentance, baptized for the remission of his/her sins, receives the Holy Spirit by the laying on of the hands of the elders, and walks in the steps of His Savior Yahshua.

Sin is the transgression of the law (1 Jn. 3:4), therefore, we must adopt Yahweh's commandments as the rule in our lives. However, while the Christian churches teach against sin, they

never describe what sin is. They continue in the commands of their master Caesar/Kaiser/chaziyr (swine) wallowing in the mire, "But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous are they, selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities. Whereas angels, which are greater in power and might, bring not railing accusation against them before Yahweh. But these, as natural brute beasts, made to be taken and destroyed, speak evil of the things that they understand not; and shall utterly perish in their own corruption; And shall receive the reward of unrighteousness, as they that count it pleasure to riot in the day time. Spots they are and blemishes, sporting themselves with their own deceivings while they feast with you; Having eves full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; beguiling unstable souls: an heart they have exercised with covetous practices; cursed children: Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam the son of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness; But was rebuked for his iniquity: the dumb ass speaking with man's voice forbad the madness of the prophet. These are wells without water, clouds that are carried with a tempest; to whom the mist of darkness is reserved for ever. For when they speak great swelling words of vanity, they allure through the lusts of the flesh, through much wantonness, those that were clean escaped from them who live in error. While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage. For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Sovereign and Saviour Yahshua the Messiah, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning. For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them. But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire," 2 Pet. 2:10-22. (The sow is, of course, a swine/*chazivr*.)

Since they have no idea what sin is, they continue to wallow in the mire of their sins. It is interesting that the term "mire" is utilized, because the ten toes of the idolatrous image of Daniel chapter two consist of iron and miry clay (Dan. 2:41). The fourth kingdom of iron is the Roman Empire headed by the Caesars/Kaisers/Czars/chaziyrs (swine).

When they eat the bread, and drink the wine or grape juice, symbolizing Jesus' (the false messiah's/anti-messiah's, the lawless, iniquitious christ's) body and blood, they are, in effect, eating swine's flesh, because they have been deceived to worship Caesar/Kaiser/chaziyr.

DECEPTION

The serpent began his deception early on in the garden of Eden. The woman Eve/Chavvah declared, "The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat," Gen. 3:13. The book of Revelation, the last book of the Scriptures, reveals that the serpent is still deceiving, as a matter of fact he has deceived the WHOLE WORLD, "And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him," Rev. 12:9.

In reality, a deceived person doesn't know he is deceived. We are all born into this world, and taught the things of this world, even the religion (-s), faith (-s) of this world, which are not the true faith. Only the Father can call us to the truth, "No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day," Jn. 6:44.

Yahshua came speaking parables in order to keep the mysteries of the kingdom hidden. He taught, "And **he spake many things unto them in parables**, saying, Behold, a sower went forth to sow; And when he sowed, some seeds fell by the way side, and the fowls came and devoured them up: Some fell upon stony places, where they had not much earth: and forthwith they sprung up, because they had no deepness of earth: And when the sun was up, they were scorched; and because they had no root, they withered away. And some fell among thorns; and the thorns sprung up, and choked them: But other fell into good ground, and brought forth fruit, some an hundredfold, some sixtyfold, some thirtyfold. Who hath ears to hear, let him hear," Mt. 13:3-9.

He explained this parable, "Hear ye therefore the parable of the sower. When any one heareth the word of the kingdom, and understandeth it not, <u>then cometh the wicked one</u>, and catcheth away that which was sown in his heart. This is he which received seed by the way side. But he that received the seed into stony places, the same is he that heareth the word, and anon with joy receiveth it; Yet hath he not root in himself, but dureth for a while: for when tribulation or persecution ariseth because of the word, by and by he is offended. He also that received seed among the thorns is he that heareth the word; and the care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, choke the word, and he becometh unfruitful. But he that received seed into the good ground is he that heareth the word, and understandeth it; which also beareth fruit, and bringeth forth, some an hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty," vv. 18-23.

The question is: Have you understood what has been presented in this document? Do you believe what has been presented here? I have explained a spiritual mystery, a spiritual parable to you. Physical, fleshly swine's flesh is not good for anyone. The swine is a living, walking garbage can. It can make you sick, but to eat of the spiritual swine's flesh of the Caesar/ Kaiser/Czar/*chaziyr* will bring tribulation, trouble, and death.

The world's false savior is celebrated with eating literal swine's flesh. There is the Christmas ham. Ham, swine, is a favorite for Easter, and other various holidays. The true Savior Yahshua is celebrated as the Passover Lamb. Therefore, Jesus is the unclean, false savior, while Yahshua is the true clean Savior.

COME OUT OF HER

The book of Revelation reveals the world's condition in these last days, "And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will shew unto thee the judgment of **the great whore** that sitteth upon many waters: **With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication**. So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, **full of names of blasphemy**, having seven heads and ten horns. And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication: And **upon her forehead was a name writ**ten, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTH-ER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH. And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Yahshua: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration," Rev. 17:1 -6.

The kings (including the Caesars/Kaisers/Czars) have been in bed with this filthy abominable harlot. They have committed fornication with her and have led their subjects to also commit fornication with her.

Again, it says, "And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory. And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird. For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies," Rev. 18:1-3.

The merchants love to sell the unclean blasphemous things that belong to the Babylonian harlot. They are considered to be delicacies, but are totally unclean. At the last, Babylon becomes the hold of every foul spirit, devils (demons) and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.

The devils/demons (Satan's angels/messengers) are leading his people to embrace the tenets of humanism, socialism, communism, capitalism, abortion, homosexuality, etc., etc.

Yahweh commands, "And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, **Come out of her, my people**, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues. For her sins have reached unto heaven, and Yahweh hath remembered her iniquities. Reward her even as she rewarded you, and double unto her double according to her works: in the cup which she hath filled fill to her double. How much she hath glorified herself, and lived deliciously, so much torment and sorrow give her: for she saith in her heart, I sit a queen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow. Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall be utterly burned with fire: for strong is the Sovereign Yahweh who judgeth her," Rev. 18:4-8.
